
## The New Senior Secondary Curriculum

## Other Learning Experiences




- It provides a framework to engage students in experiential learning and to involve them in new roles

## Main Changes from HKCEE/AL to NSS Subjects



	Existing: HKCEE/AL	Future: NSS
LS	electives	additional core subject on top of C,E,M
No. of subjects	HKCEE: 7-9 AL: 4-5	6-7/8 (S4) subjects for most students
Streaming	<b>✓</b>	No clear streaming. 2-3 electives from different KLAs courses
Subject level	HKCEE/AL	Most NSS subjects are HKCEE curricula + 1 year with AL standard
Contents	20 % change in new contents on average (except LS)	
OLE	Some students	All students have OLE
