

A happy 2011 to all parents, teachers and students! This New Year heralds the commencement of our 160th Anniversary celebrations on the 1st September and will be a year full of activity and exciting new projects. Anniversaries provide a wonderful opportunity to celebrate what has been achieved over the years as well as introducing new initiatives and plans.

To kick start preparations for the 160th Anniversary a competition was conducted to select the Anniversary Logo and Slogan. A large number of entries were received in the Primary, Secondary and Open Divisions and our sincere appreciation is extended to all who participated and submitted so many quality designs. Congratulations go to Jason Lam Pui Hin (F.1D) for the winning Logo design and to Ching Wai Chuen (alumnus 1975) for the winning Slogan. We shall be seeing the Logo and Slogan many times over the next 18 months!

The 160th anniversary celebrations will feature once again the four key events that have been the backbone of previous festivities. The first activity will be the Anniversary Exhibition Day on Saturday, 29th October, 2011; followed by the Anniversary Concert in November (date to be confirmed); the Anniversary Reunion Dinner on Sunday, 11th December, 2011; and the Anniversary Carnival on Saturday, 11th February, 2012. The Anniversary Speech Day will be on Thursday, 1st December, 2011.

In addition to the traditional four events the 160th Anniversary celebrations will feature many other activities that should cater for all interests. A Distinguished Alumni Lecture series in the College Hall is planned for the first half of this year, featuring leading alumni working in a range of professions. There will be an Anniversary Church Service at St. John's Cathedral in June where we hope to fill the Church with St. Paul's College families. The service will also be an excellent opportunity to hear the Chapel Choir just before they leave for London. The Anniversary Tour will see the Choir and members of the Chinese Orchestra perform at three of the capital's great churches: St. Paul's Cathedral, Southwark Cathedral and St. Martin's in the Fields. The chance to sing and play in such well known settings will be a once in a lifetime opportunity for our boys.

We are also looking at ways of establishing a global community of schools bearing our name. The concept of building a network of 40 or more St. Paul's Colleges or Schools outside of Hong Kong opens up exciting ideas for friendship and interaction.

To ensure that our campus is looking its best for the anniversary year, the Covered & Lower Playgrounds and the Pok Fu Lam Road entrance will be renovated and the exterior walls of the College repainted over the summer holiday.
