### 交換長的話 Principal's Message

here is nothing better than a major event to rally support for the College and to reinforce the progress being made in many different areas of the school. The Stewart Dinner on Saturday 6 December was one such event. It was 50 years ago that Colonel E.G. Stewart, the eighth Principal of the College, passed away. Colonel Stewart was an iconic figure at St. Paul's and in the wider Hong Kong community having served as leader of our school between 1930 and 1958. He is remembered most for two reasons. First, for leading the Army Volunteers in the defence of Hong Kong in December 1941. Second, for reestablishing St. Paul's College after the war and relocating our school to the Bonham Road site in September 1950.

We were honoured to have Evan Stewart's son, Colonel Michael Stewart, as Guest of Honour at the Stewart dinner. Also present was Mrs. Christine Speak, the wife of the late Rev. Geoffrey Speak who was Principal from 1959-1967. The dinner was held in the Hall and attended by over 170 alumni and special guests. It was wonderful to see so many old boys returning to their alma mater, some for the first time in many decades. In particular, there were boys from the graduating classes of the early 1950s; girls from the Classes of 1984-1986; and more recent alumni from the 1990s. The school Hall looked resplendent and a fine night was had by all. Colonel Michael Stewart presented the College with a photograph of Hong Kong taken in the late 19th century with the old St. Paul's College campus, in Lower Albert Road, taking pride of place in the very centre.

Last year the College introduced the Artist-in-Residence programme where a distinguished artist in the fields of Music, Art, Literature or Theatre is invited to come to St. Paul's for a stay of one or two weeks to work alongside our students in the classroom and after school. We were delighted that Mr. Branko Stark agreed to be the second Artist-in-Residence. Mr. Stark, a renowned Conductor and Composer from Croatia, lent his considerable talent to the students in the Music

Department. This year we also introduced programme а Teacher Visits where teachers at leading boy's schools from around the world are invited to spend a week at St. Paul's. In return, a number of our teachers will visit our brother schools overseas. We delighted to host Mr. Peter Walmsley, the Director of Bands at Barker College in Sydney, as the first teacher to participate in this new programme. Mr. Walmsley spent ten days at St. Paul's providing intensive tuition and guidance to the boys in the band. His expertise proved to be invaluable and we

look forward to many more teacher visits in the future.

The next significant capital works project for the College will be the construction of a new Primary School at the corner of Pokfulam Road and Victoria Road. It is anticipated that the new 24 classroom campus will be completed in late 2011 at which point the Primary School can start moving from its current location in Hill Road. This will be a major building project and involve additional facilities to those normally provided by Government. In order to meet the costs of the extra facilities, the school will turn to the newly established St. Paul's College Foundation. The Foundation has set an initial target of \$50 million to be used for a variety of projects, one of which being the relocation of the Primary School. The Foundation will have a major role to play in the years ahead in providing the resources necessary to ensure that the students who attend St. Paul's do so at an excellent, well-equipped campus.



#### 旅行或交流

俗語有云:「讀萬卷書,不如行萬里路。」不論境內境外的旅行,每年都必需安排。郊外旅行,子女從過程中可體驗大自然之美,有些更可學習大

量地理、科學和生物的知識,如能鼓勵子 女學習攝影,更可提升子女的觀察能力。 到境外旅行,更有機會體驗異國風情,學

> 習不同國家的文化和歷 史,而且還可學習運用不 同的語言,與人溝通。



#### 比賽

參加不同類型的比賽,可令子女見識不同領域的傑出人士,觀摩不同的致勝策略。只要是子女有興趣的項目,可以鼓勵孩子訂定不同階段的目標,逐步實現,提升孩子的

實現能力。如能陪伴子女比賽,配合教練技術指導,更可拉近與子女的距離,亦能加深了解子女的興趣。如信心不足,亦可鼓勵子女觀看不同類型的比賽,但親身參與,當然效果更佳。




#### 博物館
